A Great Little Italian Resturant

I have been to Po a few times and so far it is my favorite little italian resturant in NY. The food is fabulous, the service is great and the atmosphere is laid-back, not pretentious. If I lived in the city, I could see it being one of my favorite neighborhood resturants I would frequent. The two best tables at Po for a romantic dinner for two are the two tables in the front located in the window nooks. The Linguine Vongole is fabulous, a bit oily but still really good - I would suggest taking some immodium before hand. Other items I have had that are not on the current menu are grilled quail with reduced balsamic vinegar sauce and a wide, flat pasta with braised rabbit in a tomato sauce. Po always starts you off with excellent bread and really good olive oil. During the summer months, they have two tables for two out in front of the resturant. It's a nice place to sit if you want more of a private dinning experience. Cornelia Street is a quiet and quaint street in the West Village. Po is an italian resturant I would definitely suggest to go in NY if you want something laid-back and casual with great food.
