Located in the middle of Battery Park City, this gigantic complex aims to mix business with pleasure.

Overview

Featuring four connected, skyscraping towers, the sprawling 14-acre centerpiece of Battery Park City houses the world headquarters of American Express, Merrill Lynch, Dow Jones and Deloitte & Touche--as well as an Embassy Suites Hotel. Standing tall among the public spaces, shops and restaurants (some with outdoor dining) is the Winter Garden. Restored after the WTC attacks, this exhibition hall sports a semicircular marble staircase, a palm tree courtyard and a large stage used for music, film and dance programs.
