

Results of Evaluation of Oral Communication in CSE 758

After extensive discussion in the Undergraduate Studies Committee, a rubric was developed for evaluating oral presentations in the capstone design courses. For complete details, please see:

The rubric was piloted in Au '05 in CSE 758. There were five teams in this section of 758. Each team made a joint oral presentation and each presentation was evaluated by two or three evaluators. The results appear in the table below.

The first column in the table is a code assigned to the team. The remaining 4 columns list the scores received by the team in the four categories, respectively, *organization*, *mechanics*, *delivery*, and *relating to audience*. In each case, a team can receive a score between 1 and 4; for the precise meaning of these scores in each category, please refer to the rubric. Note that for each team there are either two or three sets of scores, depending on the number of evaluators who evaluated that presentation. In each case, the first row of numbers corresponds to the evaluation by the 758 instructor (Dr. Ramnath); the other row(s) correspond to the the other evaluator(s) who varied from team to team.
